## How to Use Hot Dog Coding Game:

1. Print out game board and coding block pages (ARROWS and NUMBERS)
2. Cut out coding blocks (ARROWS and NUMBERS)
3. Use the coding blocks to design a path for BUN to reach HOTDOG, avoiding TABLES, CHAIRS, and BUCKETS, and picking up KETCHUP on the way.
4. Use a small object representing the BUN, and follow the direction kids designed using the coding blocks, see if the BUN can reach the HOTDOG by following the codes step-by-step.
5. If the BUN reaches the HOTDOG, congratulations! If not, revise the codes and try again.

## Game Goal:

To write a direction to move BUN to reach HOTDOG, using the coding blocks (ARROWS and NUMBERS)

## Game Rules:

1. Use ARROWS to show moving directions, and use NUMBERS to show steps of the movement. For example, " $\rightarrow 2$ " means moving toward right for 2 blocks.
2. Avoid TABLES, CHAIRS, and BUCKET
3. Collect KETCHUP before reaching HOTDOG.

## Note:

1. For kids who just start, they can use two ARROWS to represent two steps. Once they master the concept, they can use " $\rightarrow 2$ " instead of " $\rightarrow \rightarrow$ "
2. If you need more coding blocks, feel free to print more ARROW and NUMBER pages.
